Scars- Settings vary based on location and type of scar. Start with conservative settings and add density and depth as you gain experience



## Notes:

- 1) For skin types IV, V, VI, pre-treat with a 4% hydroquinone topical once per day 2 wks prior to tx and 2 wks post tx
- 2) For skin types IV keep density at 15% or less for both non ablative and ablative
- 3) For skin types V keep density at 10% or less for both non ablative and ablative
- 4) Prednisone available for swelling
- 5) Benadryl 1 hour before treatment for swelling
- 6) No retinols 5 days post tx. Can resume retinols 5 days after treatment
- 7) As a general rule of thumb, space treatments out 4-6 wks
- 8) Keep your speed with the speed of the light. Stay out of the red!
- 9) Be mindful of the area where 2 zones meet (example: the middle of the neck and chest). Make sure not to double the density on accident
- 10) When in doubt do the lower density

## Dr. Robb's Acne Flare Post Halo Tips:

- 1. Halo acne flares seem to occur in about 5%
- 2. More likely to flare if: perioral dermatitis, acne on jawline, history of acne
- 3. Prophylaxis: doxycycline 100 mg po bid a week before and a month after
- 4. BBL if post flare
